III. COMPETITION DETAILS & REGULATIONS

REGULATIONS	The Tournament will be played in accordance with the regulations of the Confederation as laid down in Appendix I (<u>click here</u>) and the Laws and Regulations as adopted by the Badminton World Federation. The European Championships will be played as a knock out competition.
SCORING SYSTEM	Rally Point System = 3*21 points
COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS AND WARM-UP TIME	All events will be on a strict timetable system. Competitors should be ready to play 30 minutes before their scheduled time. Competitors who are not ready to play at their scheduled time will be disqualified. On the court, before a game, warm-up time is limited to 2 minutes.
SHUTTLECOCKS	YONEX AS-50
DRUG-TESTING	All testing will be carried out in accordance with BWF Anti-doping Regulation.
MEDAL CEREMONIES	All medals will be presented on Sunday 1 st May after the respective finals. All medalists are required to be present at the medal ceremonies.



IV. CLOTHING & ADVERTISING REGULATIONS

NAMES AND COLOURS	In doubles it is mandatory for doubles partners to wear the same colour.
	From quarter finals onwards, it is mandatory that opposing players and pairs wear different colours from each other.
	It is mandatory that the name of the player shall appear on the back of the shirt.
	It is optional whether the name of the player's association/country shall appear on the back of the shirt.
	The Referee is instructed to pay particular attention to uphold these regulations on clothing. In applying regulations on clothing the decision of the Referee shall be final.
ADVERTISING	Advertising on players' clothing must comply with the existing BWF Regulations.
	Advertising for tobacco and alcohol companies is completely forbidden by the French law.
OTHER REGULATIONS	Please refer to the regulations of the BEC Regulations in Appendix I (<u>click here</u>) for additional obligation and regulation concerning clothing.

VISA	It is the responsibility of any nations or players needing a visa to travel to the France to make sure that visa applications are made not later than March 15 th .
APPLICATION	Organizers are unable to send supporting letters at a late stage and Embassies are no longer prepared to issue "last minute" visas.
	The fact that visas cannot be obtained, will not be accepted as an excuse for a withdrawal.
MEDICAL FACILITIES	Medical and physiotherapy services will be provided at the Vendéspace. (free of charge)
PLAYERS LOUNGE	A lounge fully dedicated to the players and the teams is available in the Training Area. All kind of information, about the competition, accommodation, transportation will be available inside this area.
