Eligibility	<p>All Badminton Europe Member Associations are eligible to compete in the event.</p> <p>Member Associations are allowed to enter: 2 players in men's singles 2 players in women's singles 4 players (or up to 2 pairs) in men's doubles 4 players (or up to 2 pairs) in women's doubles 4 players (or up to 2 pairs) in mixed doubles</p> <p>The hosting association is entitled to enter one extra player in each of the single events and two extra players in each of the doubles events.</p> <p>No player can play in more than two events.</p> <p>Participants in the 2018 European U15 Championships shall be restricted to players born in 2004 or later.</p>
Substitution	<p>After the closing date for entries, a player who has entered may be unable to take part through illness, injury, or other unavoidable cause.</p> <p>That player's place in singles or doubles or both can be taken by a player from any Member Association as long as that Member Association does not exceed the quota of players for that specific event.</p>
Seeding	<p>Seeding will be made by an independent seeding panel in accordance with an official notification sent to all BEC Member Associations on 24 February 2017.</p> <p>The seeding will be announced on 31 January 2018.</p>
Shuttles	Yonex AS-50
Stringing	Yonex will provide stringing service at the event.
Regulations	The Tournament will be played in accordance with Badminton Europe's regulations as laid down in Appendix X and the Laws and Regulations as adopted by the Badminton World Federation.

Clothing and advertising	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the regulations of Badminton Europe's Appendix X – "European U15 Championships", regulations 12 and 13.</p> <p>The name of the player on the back of the shirt is optional. <i>(if used, please note that it must comply with BWF rules)</i></p> <p>The name of the player's association on the back is optional. <i>(if used, please note that it must comply with BWF rules)</i></p> <p>In applying regulations on clothing and designs and advertising on players' clothing the decision of the Referee shall be final.</p>
Anti-doping testing	<p>Anti-doping testing can be executed on a random basis during the tournament as per BWF and WADA regulations.</p>
Insurance	<p>Any medical treatment necessary away from the sports hall (e.g. at hotels or hospitalisation due to serious illness or injury) is at the players or officials own expense.</p> <p>It is recommended that associations of players or individual participants cover these risks by medical insurance.</p>
Visa Application	<p>It is the responsibility of any nation or player needing a visa to travel to the Russian Federation to make sure that visa applications are made not later than 5 January 2018.</p> <p>For more information about the visa application process, go to Badminton Europe's event website.</p> <p>Organisers are unable to send supporting letters at a late stage and Embassies are no longer prepared to issue "last minute" visas.</p> <p>The fact that visas cannot be obtained, will NOT be accepted as an excuse for a withdrawal.</p>
