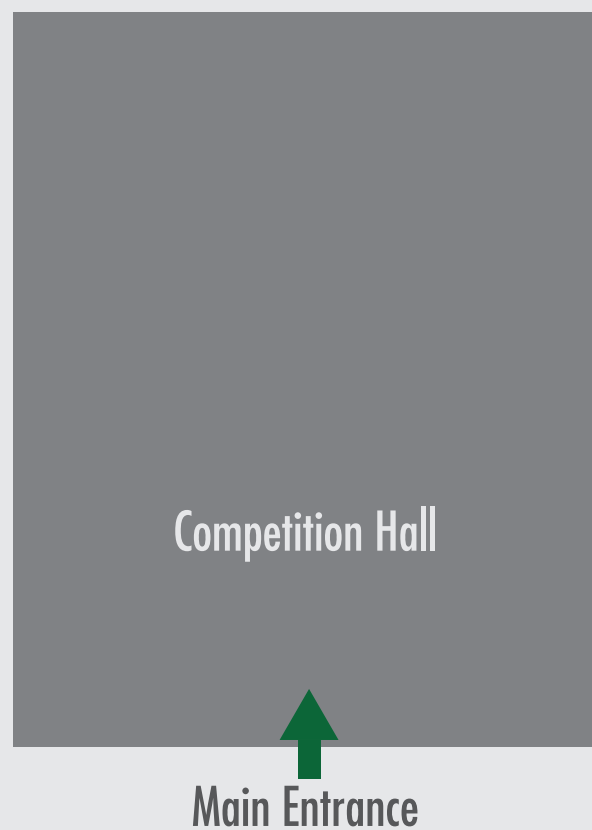
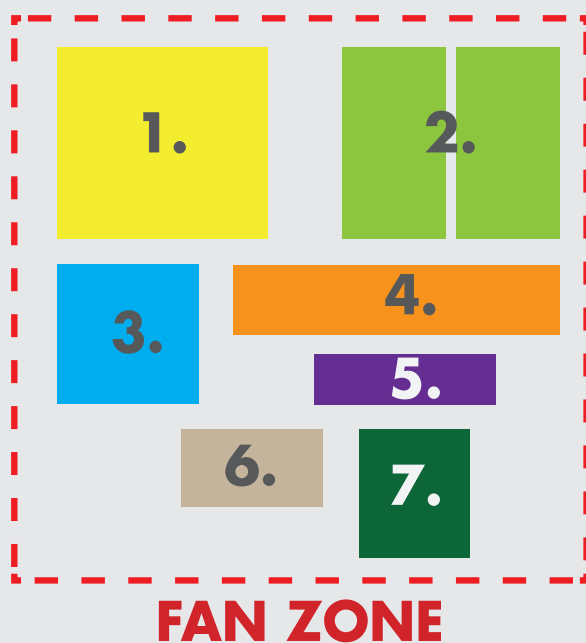
MEAL SERVICE
