Entries	<p>Badminton Europe will conduct the entry using the following timetable:</p> <p>27 February 2020 – Deadline for Member Associations to confirm whether or not eligible players/pairs will enter. 2 March 2020 – Deadline for Member Association to confirm whether or not 2nd phase players/pairs will enter. 5 March 2020 – Final deadline for Member Associations to confirm entries. 10 March 2020 – Badminton Europe will announce Wild Card entries (if applicable)</p> <p>The eligible players/pairs will be determined by Badminton Europe as per the regulations for the European Championships, therefore there will be no entry form as such.</p>
Eligibility Date	<p>The BWF World Ranking list of 18 February 2020 shall be used for deciding eligibility for the European Championships.</p>
Eligibility	<p>The BWF World Ranking list of the “Eligibility Date” shall be used to allocate places in the European Championships.</p> <p>Regulations 3.2.3 to 3.2.6 in Badminton Europe’s “Appendix A: European Championships” shall be considered in turn until a total of 48 players in each of the singles events and 32 doubles pairs in each of the doubles events are allocated, or the entries have been exhausted.</p>
Seeding Date	<p>The seeding will be announced on Friday 3 April 2020 using the World Ranking list published on Tuesday 31 March 2020.</p>
Draw Date	<p>The draw will be conducted on Tuesday 7 April 2020.</p>
Shuttles	<p>YONEX AS-50</p>
Stringing	<p>Badminton Europe’s official event partner and equipment supplier, YONEX, will provide stringing service throughout the whole event.</p>

Doping control	<p>According to the existing law in Ukraine anti-doping testing can be executed on a random basis during the tournament.</p> <p>Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.</p> <p>Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).</p> <p>For more information about anti-doping, please visit the BWF website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-doping-overview/</p>
Badminton Integrity	<p>Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.</p> <p>To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.</p> <p>Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.</p> <p>For more information, please refer to BWF's website: https://corporate.bwfbadminton.com/integrity/anti-match-fixing-overview/</p>
Insurance	<p>Any medical treatment necessary away from the sports hall (e.g. at hotels or hospitalisation due to serious illness or injury) is at the players or officials own expense.</p> <p>It is recommended that associations of players or individual participants cover these risks by medical insurance.</p>

Regulations	<p>The Tournament will be played in accordance with the regulations of the Confederation as laid down in Appendix I (Regulations for European Championships) and the Laws and Regulations as adopted by the Badminton World Federation.</p> <p>The European Championships will be played as a knock out competition.</p>
Clothing and advertising	<p>Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the regulations of the Confederation as laid down in Appendix I (Regulations for European Championships).</p> <p>In singles matches it is <u>mandatory</u> that, from the quarter finals onwards, the opposing players in each match wear different colours from each other. The player ranked lower on the BWF World Ranking used for the seeding will be required to wear clothing of a significant different colour. Where both players have the same or no ranking, the player listed lower in the draw will be required to change the colour of clothing.</p> <p>In doubles matches it is <u>mandatory</u> for doubles partners to wear the same colour.</p> <p>In doubles matches it is <u>mandatory</u> that, from the quarter finals onwards, the opposing pairs in each match wear different colours from each other. The pair ranked lower on the BWF World Ranking used for the seeding will be required to wear clothing of a significant different colour. Where both pairs have the same or no ranking, the player listed lower in the draw will be required to change the colour of clothing.</p> <p>It is <u>mandatory</u> that the name of the player shall appear on the back of the shirt.</p> <p>It is <u>optional</u> whether the name of the player's association/country shall appear on the back of the shirt.</p> <p>The Referee is instructed to pay particular attention to uphold these regulations on clothing. In applying regulations on clothing and designs and advertising on players' clothing the decision of the Referee shall be final.</p>

Medal ceremonies	<p>All medals will be presented on Sunday 26 April 2020 after the respective finals. All medalists are required to be present at the medal ceremonies.</p>
