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Information about Banská Bystrica

Banská Bystrica is considered to be the heart of Slovakia. It is surrounded by mountain ranges with national parks. Banská Bystrica with 77 000 inhabitants is the 6th largest city in Slovakia. The city is a home to three major universities – as well numerous primary and secondary schools resulting in young, vibrant and friendly atmosphere in the city.

THE CITY HAS A RICH HISTORY

The first written record dates to the 13th century. In 1255 king Belo IV promoted the status of the original Slovak settlement of Bystrica to that of a free royal city. Banská Bystrica was proclaimed as a city monument reservation, among the first in Slovakia. A significant feature of the city is its rectangular square with historical houses, a Virgin Mary column and a unique clock tower. Upon creation of the Slovak Republic in 1993, the city sought to strengthen its historical disciplines – banking, education, tourism and top sports. With the founding of Matej Bel University in 1992, Banská Bystrica became one of the centres of university education in Slovakia. Currently, Banská Bystrica is an economic, administrative and cultural centre of Central Slovakia, and a home to the Banská Bystrica Self-Governing Region.



BANSKÁ BYSTRICA – THE EUROPEAN CITY OF SPORT 2017

Banská Bystrica gained the title of 2017 European City of Sport, awarded by ACES Europe and accepted by Mayor of city in Brussels in December 2016. Sports activities carried out in Banská Bystrica lifted this positive attitude towards sports to previously unseen numbers.



HISTORY OF SPORT IN BANSKÁ BYSTRICA

The history of sports began in the year 1889 and the first sports club, BSC (Besztersybányia Sport Club), with cycling, tennis and football was established. In 1919 one of the largest sports clubs in Slovakia, Slávia Banská Bystrica was created. As the site for summer and winter sports, Banská Bystrica earned its nickname "Slovak Davos" in 1930s. 1965 was a foundation year of the army sports centre that housed football, track and field, ski-jump, judo, sports gymnastics, water polo, biathlon, fencing, modern pentathlon, sports shooting, swimming, water slalom and downhill skiing. Currently it operates as the Army Sports Centre Dukla Banská Bystrica (ASC Dukla). In 1979 was founded the first sports boarding school, the first one in Czechoslovakia. The Sport high school produced several World and European champions and Olympic athletes. Banská Bystrica has tradition in organization of various high level sport events with long history.

WEATHER CONDITIONS

In Banská Bystrica, Zvolen and their region, the summers are comfortable, the winters are freezing and dry, and it is partly cloudy year-round. Over the course of the year, the temperature typically varies from -6°C to 25°C. Based on the tourism score, the best time of year to visit Banská Bystrica for warm-weather activities is from mid-June to late August.

Covid -19	The Organising Committee is monitoring situation in close cooperation with health authorities in Slovakia and will apply all necessary matters in order to ensure maximum safety of all participants. An EYOF Covid-19 policy will be dully communicated and applied in cooperation with the EOC Medical Commission. The OC requires to have dedicated Covid-19 point of contact from each NOC.

Only NOCs having HB B and/or G teams and/or VO B teams may enter this Deputy. He/she must be accommodated in Zvolen with the team(s).
 - b. one Medical Staff for Handball (B/G) and Volleyball teams (B) that will be all accommodated in Zvolen. This is an extra quota (not included in GO quota Medical Personnel). <u>Only NOCs having HB B and/or G teams and/or VO B teams may enter this person.</u> He/she must be accommodated in Zvolen with the team(s).
- No special quota for Covid liaison manager will be allocated, such person is to be appointed from GO quota (e.g. somebody from medical personnel carrying out this role). This may be changed later based on situation regarding actual Covid measures.
- One media representative above the GO quota can be accredited within the delegation. He/she stays with the NOC delegation in the AVL.
- The team officials (Ao) are entitled to enter their respective sport's field of play only.
- It is recommended to bring 2 Ao + 1 medical staff per team sport.
- The NOC President and Secretary General are accredited as VIPs, not within the NOC Officials Quota (unless they have an operational role within the official NOC Delegation and they need to stay in the Athletes´ Village). In this case they will be included in the GO quota.

Conditions for participation and nationality of competitors

(As per the EYOF Charter)

Participation in the European Youth Olympic Festival is open to all European young athletes nominated by their National Olympic Committee, subject to the current EYOF Charter and EOC regulations on age categories and quotas published for each EYOF edition. The criteria for the qualification of athletes/teams are in the remit of the respective NOCs with the exception of team sports where the qualification systems/criteria are set up by the respective IF/EFs.

Any competitor in the EYOF must be a national or citizen of the country or territory of the NOC that is entering him/her or have the right of being a national or citizen of such country when the competitor reaches the legal age of majority. In any case, the NOC must, on the request of the Organising Committee (OC) or the EOC, duly approve the nationality, citizenship or right to obtain the one or the other by the competitor. An NOC that wishes to enter an athlete who does not meet these criteria, must submit a written and detailed request to the EYOF COCOM **not later than four months** before the date of the Opening Ceremony. The EYOF COCOM will make a recommendation to the EOC Executive Committee, which will at its sole discretion decide whether the request can be accepted or not.



Accommodation



ACCOMMODATION FOR NOC DELEGATIONS

NOC delegations will be accommodated in the existing University and High school dormitories in Banská Bystrica and Zvolen. There will be four Athletes' Villages in total, three AVLs will be located to Banská Bystrica and one (AVL 4) in the City of Zvolen. The distance between Banská Bystrica and Zvolen is 25 km, taking approximately 20 minutes of drive on highway. AVL in Zvolen will accommodate boys Volleyball teams and both boys and girls Handball teams

The four AVLs consist all together of 8 dormitories (buildings) with the total capacity of 3892 beds. Six out of these buildings are apartment style (3+1/3+2) and 2 buildings have shared bathrooms.

The Banská Bystrica AVLs will be catered in high-capacity catering tent, with shuttle bus service between all AVLs/DM, Sports venues and catering tent on regular basis.

The Organising Committee will assure same level of service across all the accommodation. There will be central NOC Services Center in AVL 1 and sub-centers in other AVLs.

Olympic Culture and Education Programme (OCEP)







The Slovak Olympic and Sports Committee (SOSC) will implement the Olympic Culture and Education Programme (OCEP) that was presented for the first time within the framework of Baku 2019 EYOF.

Being in line with the Olympic Agenda 2020 recommendations on strengthening Olympic education and strategic partnership among NOCs, the programme was very well received by the all stakeholders.

The OCEP is intended to engage and inspire youth to be true champions, to adopt and live by Olympic Values of Friendship, Excellence and Respect, and to play active roles in their communities. As part of the programme the SOSC has already selected schools from Slovakia to be twinned with one school from each of the remaining 49 European countries. In this regard, we would like to ask each NOC across Europe to select one local school to be twinned with a selected school in Slovakia. In terms of selection criteria, secondary school students with good English proficiency and willing to enter into international cooperation are the priority. The invitation to NOCs for the school participation nominating has been sent with a deadline 31 January 2022.

Taking into account the unique specificity of the programme the SOSC has decided to engage Young Ambassadors for the EYOF into the programme implementation. Hence, selected Young Ambassadors across Europe will be invited to get in touch and support twinning schools with their promotional and educational activities.

We believe that all European NOCs will join the OCEP programme in order to strengthen the promotion of sport as a key element in this enlightening cultural exchange, and enhance cooperation between young people of member countries. ACCOMMODATION & TRAVEL:

- The European Young Olympic Ambassadors (EYOA) should arrive together with their delegations. NOCs should include a EYOA quota in the Final Entries by Number in RAS and complete the registration following the standard deadlines for Long list and Short list. European Young Olympic Ambassadors will get a NOC accreditation, Ambassadors category with Ao access rights.
- Accommodation costs for the EYOA will be covered by the EOC. The accommodation fee will be initially
 paid by the respective NOC and will be reimbursed by the EOC, upon the presentation of the needed
 documents. Accommodation will be provided in the Athletes' Village.
- Travel will be at their NOC's expense.

MASCOT


