Provisional schedule	Wednesday 21 September: Round of 128 and Round of 64 (from 9h) <u>Thursday 22 September</u> : Round of 64 and Round of 32 (from 9h) <u>Friday 23 September</u> : Round of 32, Round of 16 and Quarter Finals (from 9h) <u>Saturday 24 September</u> : Semi Finals and Finals (from 9h)
	Please note that this is only a provisional schedule. If possible, we will try to play only the finals on 24/09. The final schedule will be published shortly after the entry deadline.
Eligibility	All Badminton Europe Members are eligible to compete in the event.
	Members are allowed to enter: 2 players in men's singles 2 players in women's singles 4 players (or up to 2 pairs) in men's doubles 4 players (or up to 2 pairs) in women's doubles 4 players (or up to 2 pairs) in mixed doubles
	The hosting Member is entitled to enter one extra player in each of the single events and two extra players in each of the doubles events.
	Players are allowed to enter in the 3 events.
	Participants in the 2022 European U15 Championships shall be restricted to players born in 2008 or later .
	Note: As per decisions made by the BEC Board of Directors any Federation currently declared not in Good Standing, shall not be eligible to receive funding from BEC nor enter to any activity organised or sanctioned by BEC.
Substitution	After the closing date for entries, a player who has entered may be unable to take part through illness, injury, or other unavoidable cause.
	That player's place in singles or doubles or both can be taken by a player from any Member as long as that Member does not exceed the quota of players for that specific event.

Seeding	Seeding will be made by an independent seeding panel in accordance with an official notification sent to all BEC Members on 2 March 2022.
	The seeding will be announced on 13 September 2022 .
Draw	The draw will be conducted and published on 13 September 2022 .

Regulations	The Tournament will be played in accordance with Badminton Europe's regulations as laid down in Appendix X and the Laws and Regulations as adopted by the Badminton World Federation.
Clothing and advertising	Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the regulations of Badminton Europe's Appendix X – "European U15 Championships", regulations 11 and 12.
	The name of the player on the back of the shirt is optional. <i>(if used, please note that it must comply with BWF rules)</i>
	The name of the player's country on the back is optional. <i>(if used, please note that it must comply with BWF rules)</i>
	In applying regulations on clothing and designs and advertising on players' clothing the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Doping control	Anti-doping testing can be executed on a random basis during the tournament as per BWF and WADA regulations.
	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).

Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code of Conduct in Relation to Betting, Wagering and Irregular Match Results) relates to anti-corruption and anti- match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.

	To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, respect the principle of fair play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.
	Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a matches.

Visa Application	It is the responsibility of any nation or player needing a visa to travel to Spain to make sure that visa applications are made not later than 26 August 2022.
