2. Entry Details

Regulations	The Tournament will be played in accordance with the Badminton Europe regulations as laid down in App. II – (European Mixed Team Championships) and the Laws and Regulations as adopted by the Badminton World Federation.
Eligibility	All Badminton Europe Members are eligible to compete in the event. Each Member can enter a maximum of one team. In this connection we draw your attention to the BWF Competition Regulations 6 on International Representation.
Team Entry	Team entries must be made no later than 11 December 2024 - 14.00 CET. Entries must be made online using the following link: https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/sport/tournament.aspx?id=82d99c6c-963b-4431-badc-a2e76861a5f9
Nomination of players	Player nominations must be submitted no later than <u>9 February 2025 23.59 CET.</u> Player nominations must be submitted online using the following link: https://bwf.tournamentsoftware.com/sport/tournament.aspx?id=82d99c6c-963b-4431-badc-a2e76861a5f9 Each competing Member shall nominate not fewer than four players (4) and not more than twenty (20) players. There shall be a minimum of two male and two















female players and a maximum of ten male and ten female players amongst the nominated players.

Only nominated players shall be permitted to play as selected players or substitutes. No additional players can be nominated after the deadline listed above.

All players nominated must be listed in order of singles strength. Players having a World Ranking position in BWF World Ranking of 4 February 2025 will automatically be ranked higher by the software, while the remaining players will be ranked as nominated by the association. This order cannot be changed at a later stage.

Compliance with GCR 7.9: "In making or authorizing entries, the Member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the Players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and Disciplinary processes."

Withdrawal

If a Member withdraws a team from the Championships, after the entry deadline, but before the draw, for any reason whatsoever, such a Member shall be liable of paying its entry fee and be penalized by an administrative fine of 1.500,00 EUR per team.

If a Member withdraws a team from the Championships, after the draw is conducted, for any reason whatsoever, such a Member shall be liable of paying its entry fee and shall be penalized with a maximum fine of 5.000,00 EUR, following the procedure as defined per Badminton Europe Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Regulations.

If a Member withdraws a team, qualified for the final stage, from the Championships, for any reason whatsoever, such a Member shall be liable of paying its entry fee and shall be penalized with a maximum fine of 20.000,00 EUR, following the procedure as defined per Badminton Europe Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Regulations.

Stringing	Badminton Europe's official event partner and equipment supplier, YONEX, will provide stringing service throughout the event.
Player's lounge	A lounge fully dedicated to the players and officials is available at the venue. within the players lounge there will be snacks, fruits and coffee/tea.
Physio facilities	Physio therapy services will be possible at the venue from 10 to 18 every day, at the rate of 50 Euro/hour and 25 Euro for half an hour.

Technical Official briefing	Technical Official briefing: Tuesday 11 February 2025 at 20.00 in the TO hotel.
Clothing and advertising	Clothing and advertising will be permitted in accordance with the regulations for European Men's & Women's Team Championships (Regulations 16-17).
	In team matches players must wear team colours. That is each player must wear the same colour and design of shirts and shorts (or other equivalent articles of clothing) throughout a tie. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 500,00 EUR for each tie.
	It is mandatory that the opposing teams in each tie wear different colours from each other. The team ranked lower on the overall ranking list in 6.4 will be required to wear clothing of a significant different colour. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 200,00 EUR for each tie.
	The name of the player's country on the back of the shirt is mandatory. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 100,00 EUR for each breach.
	The name of the player on the back of the shirt is optional.
	Advertising on players' clothing must comply with the existing BWF Regulations.
	In applying regulations on clothing and designs and advertising on players' clothing the decision of the Referee shall be final.
Badminton Integrity	Section 2.4 of the BWF Statutes (Code on The Prevention of The Manipulation of Competitions) relates to anti-corruption and anti-match manipulation, and this code applies to all participants at this tournament.













	To protect the integrity of BWF sanctioned tournaments, participants are not
	allowed to bet in any way on badminton matches, shall respect the principle of fair
	play, and shall not attempt to influence the course or result of a game or match.
	Every person has an obligation to report to the BWF any approaches by anyone to gather inside information or to change the outcome of a match(es).

Doping control	Anti-doping testing may be carried out on a random basis at any time, as per BWF and WADA regulations.
	Doping control in badminton, in accordance with BWF Anti-Doping Regulations, is conducted out-of-competition and in-competition with the collection of urine and/or blood samples.
	Athletes are responsible for any substance found in their body. Before an athlete takes any medication, they should check with their doctor, and if necessary, get a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE).
